



## **Wine List**

### **White Wine**

1. PUENTE DEL INCA CHARDONNAY 2006/07, CENTRAL VALLEY – CHILE  
Firm, rounded, good clean modern Chilean Chardonnay.  
(2) 13% vol btl: £10.50
  
2. VILLA ROSA SAUVIGNON BLANC 2006/07, CURICO – CHILE  
Lightly floral with a bright line running through it to give a refreshing clean zippy wine.  
(1) 13% vol btl: £11.00
  
3. SAN ALESSANDRO PINOT GRIGIO 2006/07, VENETO – ITALY  
Light and polished with almost tangible floral notes and a delicate nutty touch.  
(2) 12% vol btl: £12.00
  
4. RIESLING KABINETT 2005/06, REH KENDERMANN – GERMANY  
White-and-green, fresh and grassy, quite sweet and well balanced with some edge. Clean pure style.  
(4) 8.5% vol btl: £13.00
  
5. PETER LEHMANN CHENIN BLANC 2006/07, BAROSSA  
Definitely a Lehmann wine, packed with fruit and flavour. Green and gold, high-toned, yet full of sun and bursting with the sweet-and-sour intensity of Chenin that others find difficult to tame.

6. BENCHMARK CHARDONNAY, GRANT BURGE 2006/07 – SOUTH AUSTRALIA  
Clean, pure fruit style with tropical fruit and not a jot of oak to interfere – just bright, fresh chardonnay in all its glory. Another classic from this iconic winemaker.  
(2) 13.5% vol btl: £14.00
  
7. MÂCON-LUGNY LES GENIÈVRES 2005/06, LOUIS LATOUR – FRANCE  
Bright favourite from the Latour stable, with fresh grassy notes, plenty of tropical fruit and a firm roundness. Good ripe Chardonnay, with a touch of age, from one of Burgundy's most durable producers.

8. POUILLY FUMÉ LES LOGERES 2005/06, GUY SAGET – FRANCE  
Classic Pouilly from the central vineyards of the Loire. Crisply refreshing, aromatic fruit and an underlying suggestion of flint.  
(1) 12.5% vol btl: £19.50

### **Rosé Wine**

9. CINSAULT-SYRAH ROSÉ, LAURENT MIQUEL 2005/06, PAYS D'OC – FRANCE  
This innovative family firm produces their modern dry Rosé in a bright fruity style that is positively full-flavoured and almost serious. Vivid redcurrant fruit drives a super fresh experience.  
(2) 13% vol btl: £12.50



### **Red Wine**

10. PUENTE DEL INCA MERLOT 2006/07, CENTRAL VALLEY – CHILE  
Youthful purple colour, Soft fruit, smooth on the palate and very drinkable.

(C) 13% vol

11. VILLA ROSA CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2005/06

Open and friendly, with berry fruit and a flash of blackcurrant, it has a nice leafy edge and a touch of oak for added breadth. A light, easy, fruity wine.

12. MERLOT, CAVES DE BERTICOT 2005/06, CÔTES DE DURAS – FRANCE

No heaviness, here is a light supple Merlot wine that takes its cue from many traditional light wines made in neighbouring Bordeaux.

13. NUVIANA TEMPRANILLO-CABERNET 2005/06, VALLE DEL CINCA

A wine which is single-handedly shining a light on its quiet corner of Aragon. It has an “ooh” factor of soft ripe fruit at the very first sniff and holds a fresh lean long line of flavour perfectly.

14. GALLEANO ZINFANDEL 2005/06, CALIFORNIA – U.S.A.

Dark fruit in a good berry style. Ripe, juicy character with a touch of bramble. Big and spicy in the mouth, easy and open with a warm burst of alcohol on the finish.

15. BENCHMARK SHIRAZ, GRANT BURGE 2005/06

Rich aromas of pepper, dark berries and spice. On the palate there are layers of oak, fruit and savoury spice with a smooth finish as long as a tiger’s tail.

16. MADFISH PINOT NOIR 2005/06 – WESTERN AUSTRALIA

Aromas of dark berry fruits and violets with a gamey, mushroom complexity and savoury French oak influences. Black cherry and strawberry lead into a rich mid-palate and end with long spice.

17. FLEURIE BELLE GRÂCE 2005/06, AJOUX – FRANCE

Absolutely classic raspberries and cream nose that is vibrantly attractive. Soft texture and enticing berry fruit are given a little weight of concentration to make it a serious contender.

### 18. BACH PLATINUM CAVA RESERVA NV – SPAIN

This cool, understated Reserva proves worthy of attention. The bouquet is appley with a hint of fresh herbs, while in the palate apple and citrus fruit flavours are in balance with the racy edge and make a long, cool finish.

### 19. CAMEL VALLEY BRUT 2006/07 CAMEL VALLEY VINEYARD, CORNWALL – ENGLAND

Superb golden sparkler with elegant fizz and full, ripe flavour, yet truly brut. This latest vintage shows a brilliant freshness.
